REQUIREMENTS:

- Up to **two (2)** entries per member will be accepted. Number of works accepted will be determined by space. Submit JPEGs of your work to: goshenartleague@gmail.com
- Submit work suitable for viewing in a public place of business. The gallery space is in the lobby of an office building.
- All styles from traditional realism to abstract to conceptual are welcome and encouraged.
- Small-medium sculptures, fine jewelry and 3D works accepted. There is limited tabletop, pedestal, and display cabinet space for these works so they are accepted on a first registered, first served basis.

- **VERY IMPORTANT:** All works must be suitably WIRED and ready for hanging. No sawtooth or other type of hanging hardware will be accepted. If you have any questions, email GAL well in advance. GAL reserves the right to refuse any works that are unsafe, improperly framed or wired, still wet, or unsuitable for hanging in any other way. In the past, your installation and curating team would repair frames and wires, etc. for you. In the time of COVID, that is no longer possible. We will have to turn your work away if it does not meet hanging requirements.

- Labels for the exhibition are prepared in advance, so your email submission must include the following for EACH PIECE. Please follow this format exactly. SUBMIT ONE LABEL PER PIECE.

--- Artist (this is your name exactly as you want it to appear on the label)

--- Title of Work

--- Medium

---Dimensions

---Sale price or NFS (Not for Sale) or POR (Price on Request)

- The following is also required in the body of your email submission - do not take for granted that we have this information, please. We need it handy to copy and paste into our paperwork.

--- Preferred email address (for publication on labels, printed matter, and in press materials where applicable)

--- Phone number (for GAL use ONLY)

ATTENTION: Works must be delivered and retrieved on dates and times indicated. This is a public lobby space. Artworks cannot be stored. If you have any problems with the agreed upon times, contact GAL via email WELL in advance. If you cannot pick up your works as indicated, please make arrangements with a representative to do so. If a representative is dropping off your work, be certain that they have ALL the necessary information and will agree to take the time to sign in for you properly.

Only artworks will be accepted at the site. All protective wrappings and carrying devices must be removed by artist/representative and taken from premises.

BY SUBMITTING, artists agree that all works will remain until the end date of the exhibit. If you need to remove a piece that has been sold, Goshen Art League must be notified immediately, and the piece must be replaced with a work of the same size.

Absolutely no artworks may be moved, installed, or removed unless prior arrangements have been made and a designated member of the curating/installation team is present.

We look forward to collaborating with you on this exhibit.
